Conference Registration

We are very pleased to announce the **2011 Children's Justice Symposium / Utah Prosecution Council Domestic Violence Conference** to be held May 17-19, 2011 at the Zermatt Resort in Midway, Utah. The Symposium Agenda includes the Breakout Session Descriptions which can be used for selecting the breakout sessions as requested on the registration form.

ALL symposium registrations **MUST** be processed through the on-line electronic system, and then payment made to the Attorney General's Office (see specific instructions on the registration form). The Regular **On-Time Registration Fee** is **\$75/person** for complete registrations and payments received by the AG's Office **on or before 5:00 pm Wednesday, April 20, 2011**. For all registrations received after April 20, 2011, the **late registration rate** of **\$90/person** will apply. No exceptions.

Please keep in mind that submission of the on-line form alone does NOT confirm on-time registration. Registration confirmation is complete only when BOTH the completed on-line registration form has been submitted and received AND payment for that registration has also been received by the AG's Office. Lodging at Zermatt Resort

Individuals who want to make hotel lodging reservations can do so by contacting the Zermatt Resort at: **855-839-7817**. Please be sure to mention that you are participating in the 2011 Children's Justice Symposium/UPC Domestic Violence Conference in order to qualify for the negotiated state rates: \$90/night for a single room and \$99 for double-occupancy.

When making reservations, individuals will need to provide a credit card to guarantee the lodging reservation and will then be responsible for all changes, cancellations and/or other charges related to their hotel reservations. Please be sure to check with the hotel regarding cancellation and change policies. As all rooms are available on a first-come, first-served basis, we suggest that you make your lodging reservations as soon as possible. Also, please note that registering for the symposium/conference does NOT include lodging. All lodging reservations must be handled separately.

Hotel Check-In and Check-Out

Zermatt has, again this year, arranged for special check-in and check-out times for Symposium Participants. Hotel Check-In time on Tuesday, May 17, 2011, is **3:00 pm** and Check-Out time on Thursday, May 19, 2011 is **1:00 pm** to allow for people to check out after the final session. Please note, however, that the late check-out time does put the hotel staff at a bit of a disadvantage as they have to get the rooms cleaned for in-coming guests. So, if you can check-out earlier please do. Additionally, as the hotel has already made these special considerations, please do NOT ask for any further late check-out concessions. Thank you.

General Conference Information

We are very excited about our terrific line-up of excellent speakers and presentations for this year's Symposium. We are looking forward to a wonderful turnout of participants from across the State of Utah. In an effort to help things run as smoothly as possible, please note the following:

- 1) **No babies / toddlers / children** in arms or carriers, strollers, etc. will be allowed in the main Conference Center during the times when presentations are in session. **No exceptions.** If your family members are joining you for meals, we welcome them into the dining areas during the times meals are served and then ask they return to the hotel to enjoy the fabulous amenities available there, while conference participants are taking advantage of the great program we have planned.
- 2) **No dogs** will be allowed in the main Conference Center during the Symposium. **No exceptions.**
- 3) When the Breakout Session rooms are full – all seats are taken – the rooms will be closed. Once the doors are closed, you'll be asked to find another session to attend. The rooms have been set to fullest capacity seating and no additional chairs will be added to aisles, sides, etc. so that we stay in compliance with fire codes and regulations. If you want to attend a specific session, please plan to get there early to make sure you get a seat.
- 4) Due to the large number of participants, we are asking for your cooperation in getting to and from presentation sessions and meals in a timely manner in order to make sure that we keep things running on time. The Agenda (available in this Program) provides descriptions of the presentations – please take time before the sessions to decide what you want to attend and where the session is being presented. If you have questions about where things are located, floor diagrams are available in this Program as well as at the Conference Registration Table.

Conference Meals

Breakfast will be served on both **Wednesday, May 18, 2011** and **Thursday, May 19, 2011**, from **6:30 am to 8:15 am** in the Matterhorn Ballroom. **Lunch** on **Wednesday, May 18, 2011**, will be served from 11:45 am to 12:45 pm **outside the Bernese Exhibit Hall** (weather permitting).

Both breakfasts and Wednesday's lunch are included as part of the regular registration fee paid by Conference Participants. Participants will need to present their name tag upon entering the dining room or buffet lines. No exceptions.
